

# What to Bring Checklist

# DIGITAL FIELD PHOTOGRAPHY WORKSHOP

This workshop will be taught using digital techniques for participant reviews and critiques. Film equipment is welcome but photographers should also make digital versions of their compositions for review.

WEATHER Variable weather can surprise the unprepared. Please check local forecasts to be better prepared for expected conditions. Bring versatile, layered accesible clothing. Weather changes can be the photographer's best friend. With change, photogenic atmospheres and opportunities may present themselves.

\* Items marked with an asterisk are NOT absolutely necessary - unless YOU think so.\*

### YOUR PHOTOGRAPHS FOR REVIEW

Bring samples of your previous work for review. Especially useful are things you are working on or have some questions about. Examples can be prints or digital files I can download on my Macbook Pro laptop for projection and review.

### CLOTHING:

Rain Parka/Wind breaker shell

Layered clothing appropriate for climate at location

Hiking boots or comfortable walking shoes you won't mind getting wet.

Raingear for your camera and tripod (think plastic bag)

Small umbrella for camera bag

## PHOTO EQUIPMENT ALL:

Tripod (for accurate composing and sharing/critiquing compositions in the field)

Digital Camera with manual capability for exposure & focus.

Camera Operating Instruction Manual

Lenses, from wide to short telephoto

Memory cards or other portable storage unit for digital cameras

Batteries - Plenty of them for digital shooting and/or battery charger

# Cable or remote release or self-timer in camera

Lens hoods or small dark gobo card to shield lens from sun flare

- \*Polarizing filter (circular polarizer for digital and modern slr film cameras)
- \*Graduated neutral density filters

Plastic bags of various sizes for foul-weather protection

Camera bag or backpack to carry gear, clothing, water snacks.

Reading glasses - if you use them, bring an extra pair for your camera bag

\* A computer or tablet and the means for downloading your images to it.

## **MISCELLANEOUS**

Small pad w. pen or a digital recorder for note making.

\* Cell phone

Water and water bottle - Energy bars or similar snack

## BEFORE COMING TO THE WORKSHOP

Make sure you are comfortable with and know how to operate all the equipment you bring.

Check and clear digital memory so you will have plenty of storage.

Check and charge up all chargeable batteries.
